Ministry of Mines and Energy





First in a series of Ministerial meetings with Cambodia, is a roundtable with H.E. Ty Narin, Secretary of State for Mines & Energy on 18 October.

The meeting covered topics such as Cambodia's push to reduce the use of coal in its electricity generation by moving initially to cleaner fossil fuels like LNG and then boosting renewable energy sources over the next decade or so. Moves to develop more solar powered generation and create the right investment climate and other renewable energy sources was also discussed.

Director-General of Customs & Excise



Carrying on from our first Cambodia meeting, the EU-ASEAN Business council had a meeting with **H.E. Dr Kun Nhem, the Director-General of Customs & Excise,** the next day on 19 October.

The excellent discussion covered treatment of gold by Customs, parallel imports, low value shipments, ecommerce, insurance issues and a range of illicit trade issues.



Ministry of Commerce



21 October saw the third of the EU-ASEAN Business Council Cambodia meetings with **H.E. Pan Sorasak, Minister of Commerce**.

Full range of issues covered include Cambodia's plans for its Chairmanship of ASEAN in 2022; trade facilitation; prevention of illicit trade; developments in the Digital Economy and E-Commerce and among others.



Ministry of Health



The meeting with **H.E Dr Or Vandine, Ministry of Health on** 22 October was a fruitful one with comprehensive answers to the many issues raised including licencing for importation of medicines and medical products; parallel imports; prevention of falsified and counterfeit medicines; private-public sector collaboration in areas such as diabetes prevention and early childhood nutrition; developments in digital healthcare; putting in place a minimum purchase age for alcohol; and, enforcement of health warnings for tobacco.



Ministry of Post and Telecommunications



Continuing the momentum for the EU-ASEAN Business Council's Cambodia meetings, we met with **H.E. Chea Vandeth, Minister for Post and Telecommunications** on 28 October. The meeting covered good ground including the ongoing postal sector reform, Cambodia's plan as they took over ASEAN Chairmanship from Brunei, e-commerce, digital skillsets, opportunities for micro-insurance sector in Cambodia, regulations on Cloud systems and more.

Attendees learnt about how to interrogate Bills of Lading and other available documents to work out how to see possible illegal shipments among others.
